

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION PERSONNEL STANDARDS AND REVIEW BOARD ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Chapter 81-442, Florida Statutes, and Okaloosa Circuit Court Orders dated May 20, 2015, July 2, 2015, and February 2, 2017 in Case 2011 CA2155, a Special Election with a limited purpose as referenced in the above case number will be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, for the employees of the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department to select two (2) members to serve on the Personnel Standards and Review Board.

Candidates for these seats must not be currently employed with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department, nor shall any candidate be in the immediate family of any person who is currently employed with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department. Candidates are encouraged to submit a 500-word/one-page biography which will be distributed to all eligible electors.

There are no restrictions on location of residency, provided that candidates are otherwise qualified electors of Okaloosa County. All candidates are elected at large, by plurality.

The qualifying period will be held beginning at noon on Monday, April 17, 2017, and close at noon on Friday, April 21, 2017.

The election schedule is as follows: Early voting will be held in the Supervisor of Elections' Offices at 302 Wilson St N, Suite 102, Crestview; and 1250 Eglin Parkway, Suite 103, Shalimar, from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., May 8 – 12, 2017.

Voting will be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m., in the Supervisor of Elections' Crestview and Shalimar offices.

Only Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department employees are eligible to vote in this election.
