## **OKALOOSA COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS TO CLOSE OFFICE LOBBIES BEGINNING APRIL 3, 2020**

APRIL 2, 2020 – CRESTVIEW, FL – Following the conclusion of election activities related to the 2020 Presidential Preference Primary and Municipal Elections, the Okaloosa County Supervisor of Elections will close office lobbies on Friday, April 3, 2020, due to concerns stemming from the novel coronavirus COVID-19. Office staff will still be available by phone and information is always available at [www.voteokaloosa.gov](http://www.voteokaloosa.gov). Candidates who need to submit paperwork or consult with the Candidate Coordinator can make an appointment by phone at (850)689-5600. Drop boxes will be available immediately outside either office for paper registration forms. The Supervisor of Elections asks that the drop box by each office be used, not the exterior Tax Collector drop boxes. Any questions should be directed, by phone, to the offices at (850)689-5600 for Crestview or (850)651-7272 for Shalimar. Voter registration, vote-by-mail ballot requests, address and party changes and more, are easily accessible at [www.voteokaloosa.gov](http://www.voteokaloosa.gov). This closure will be re-evaluated on May 1, 2020; information will be posted at [www.voteokaloosa.gov](http://www.voteokaloosa.gov) and on the Okaloosa County Supervisor of Election's Facebook page.
