

NOTICE OF SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION ALMARANTE FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Almarante Fire Control District has called for a special non-binding referendum to be placed on the ballot in conjunction with the August 18, 2020 Primary Election. The referendum was approved at a legally advertised meeting held on Thursday, December 19, 2019, by Resolution No. 2019-01.

The non-binding referendum question shall be voted upon only by residents of the Almarante Fire Control District in Precincts 5, 6, and 7, who are registered to vote no later than Monday, July 20, 2020. Polling places shall be open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, August 18, 2020.

The referendum shall be composed of the following question:

CREATION OF INDEPENDENT FIRE DISTRICT FOR ALMARANTE COMMUNITY

Shall an independent special district be created for the Almarante Fire District to continue providing quality fire and rescue services for the residents of the Almarante Community with the authority to levy assessments, fees, charges and millage not to exceed 3.75 mills pursuant to §191.009, *Florida Statutes*?
