OKALOOSA COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OFFICE TO SUSPEND EARLY VOTING IN PREPARATION OF HURRICANE ZETA

Sites to close early on Wednesday, October 28, and open late on Thursday, October 29.

October 27, 2020 – Crestview, FL –Supervisor of Elections Paul Lux has announced that all Early Voting sites in Okaloosa County will close early on Wednesday, October 28, 2020, in preparation of tropical storm conditions associated with Hurricane Zeta.

Out of an abundance of caution and concern for the safety of the public, poll workers, and staff, Early Voting sites will close at 5:00 pm on October 28, 2020, and reopen at 9:00 am on Thursday, October 29, 2020, to accommodate any potential impact from the storm.
