Ordinance to Dissolve the City of Laurel Hill

Shall the City of Laurel Hill, Florida be dissolved, and its charter revoked? The ordinance provides for the adoption of a dissolution plan within 90 days of the approval of the ordinance by the voters and includes provisions for the equitable treatment of employees, transfer of assets, and the assumption of debt by Okaloosa County, among other things.

Vote-by-mail ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office by 7pm on Election Day in order to be counted.
- **Early voting** will be held Monday, March 1 – Friday, March 5, at the Supervisor of Elections Offices in Crestview and Shalimar. Hours of operation are 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.
- Your polling places (see reverse) for registered city residents will be open from 7am to 7pm on March 9, 2021, Election Day.
