Registration Open for Candidate Education Program Offered by Supervisor of Elections Office

March 14, 2022 – The Okaloosa County Supervisor of Elections Office is offering two Candidate University classes to prepare candidates for qualifying for the 2022 election cycle. The program is for those seeking to run for public office or any member of the public interested in learning about the process. It is designed to educate interested persons of the appropriate procedures and documents required to run for office in Okaloosa County.

Candidate University consists of a three-hour curriculum focused on the fundamentals of becoming and being a candidate. Participants will be introduced to each step involved in the process including pre-filing, collecting petitions and qualifying. Campaign pitfalls will also be discussed. All participants will receive a certificate upon completion of the program. This is a free event but pre-registration is required.
