Voter Id

In order to vote online students will need to access their ballot using a Voter Id. Before voting begins your school will receive Voter Id numbers equal in number to your school's student population plus a 20% contingency cushion. Voter IDs will be labeled K-5, 6-8 or 9-12. Note: Each Voter Id is specifically assigned to a ballot. If a Voter ID does not work make sure the student is accessing the correct ballot.

Online Voting

1. Voting is easy!! In the browser address window type in your URL:

2. The ballot sign in page will open. Please enter your Voter Id and click 'Sign In.' Note: After the vote has been cast this page will automatically reappear after ten seconds. Remember, if you close out of your Internet browser and need to return, follow the instructions again. If the browser is closed before the student has voted, the student can re-enter the Voter Id number, make selections and submit the ballot.
