

NOTICE OF CANVASSING BOARD MEETINGS

Pursuant to Section 101.68(2)(a) Florida Statutes, this is to advise that the Canvassing Boards for the March 13, 2018, Municipal Elections will meet in the Supervisor of Elections office (unless otherwise noted), 302 N Wilson St, Ste 102, Crestview, as follows:

City of Destin	4:00 pm, Monday, March 12, 2018 5:30 pm, Tuesday, March 13, 2018 8:00 am, Friday, March 16, 2018
City of Mary Esther	5:00 pm, Tuesday, March 13, 2018 8:00 am, Friday, March 16, 2018
City of Valparaiso	5:00 pm, Tuesday, March 13, 2018 (at Valparaiso City Hall) 8:00 am, Friday, March 16, 2018

Any voter who needs to update his or her signature must do so before the 4:00 pm, March 12, 2018, Canvassing Board meeting. Vote-by-mail ballots will be available for public review beginning at 8:00 am on Monday, March 12, 2018, until the Canvassing Board convenes.

The Canvassing Boards shall canvass and process vote-by-mail ballots, pursuant to Section 101.68(2)(a) Florida Statutes. If any elector present at the canvassing believes any ballot is illegal due to defect apparent on the Voter's Certificate, that elector may file a protest **before** the ballot is removed from the mailing envelope [F.S. 101.68(2)(c)2]. The results of this voting shall not be released until the polls close at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, March 13, 2018.

The Boards will reconvene on Friday, March 16, 2018, as detailed above to verify and process any provisional ballots, to certify election results, and to randomly select the precincts to be audited in accordance with F.S. 101.591.
