-  Only City of Fort Walton Beach residents registered to vote on or before February 13, 2017, are eligible to vote in this election.
-  If you have moved since you last voted, please check with the Supervisor of Elections Office to verify if you are still eligible for this city election.
-  **Move your polling place to your living room.** Request your ballot by contacting the Supervisor of Elections Office via telephone, email, mail, in person or by visiting our website. Vote-by-mail ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office by 7pm on Election Day in order to be counted.
-  **Early voting** will be held Monday, March 6 – Friday, March 10, at the Supervisor of Elections Office in Crestview and Shalimar. Hours of operation are 8am – 5pm.
-  Polling places (see reverse) for registered city residents are open from 7am to 7pm on March 14, 2017.
