

SECRECY SLEEVE

*Please read ALL instructions carefully
before marking your ballot*

IMPORTANT

Mail your ballot in time to be received by the Supervisor of Elections office no later than 7:00 pm on Election Day

TO ENSURE YOUR BALLOT WILL BE COUNTED:

1. Mark your ballot in secret, unless you are in need of assistance.
 - ★ Mark only the number of candidates or issue choices as indicated on the race.
 - ★ Do not make any other identifying marks on your ballot.

2. **You must SIGN the Voter's Certificate on the RETURN ENVELOPE before mailing.** A vote-by-mail ballot will be considered illegal if the signature on this Voter's Certificate does not match your signature on record. To update your signature, send it on a voter registration form so that it is received no later than the start of the canvassing of vote-by-mail ballots - no later than the 15th day before the election. Florida Voter Registration Applications can be found at www.GoVote-Okaloosa.com or at www.registertovoteflorida.gov.

TO RETURN YOUR BALLOT BY MAIL: Be aware - as of January 10, 2015, USPS first class mail can take between 3-5 days for delivery, so mail at least 5 days before Election Day.

1. **FOLD** your marked ballot into this secrecy sleeve
2. **INSERT** the secrecy sleeve with ballot into the return envelope and seal it. Return ONLY ONE ballot per envelope. Households cannot combine ballots into one envelope.
3. **COMPLETE** the Voter's Certificate on the RETURN ENVELOPE. SIGN and DATE, or your ballot may not be counted.

How to Cast Your Ballot

1. **MARK** your ballot:
 - Review your ballot and follow instructions
 - Fill in the oval next to your selection(s)
 - Place your marked ballot inside this secrecy sleeve
2. **SEAL** your Voter's Certificate return envelope:
 - Enclose your ballot and secrecy sleeve in your Voter's Certificate return envelope
 - Seal the envelope
3. **SIGN** your Voter's Certificate return envelope:
 - Sign your name in the box below the red arrow
 - Write the date under your signature in the same box
4. **APPLY** postage:
 - Requires a First Class Stamp
5. **RETURN** by 7 pm (CST) Election Day:
 - Mail your ballot so it arrives before/on Election Day, or
 - Deliver your ballot to the Supervisor of Elections office by 7 pm CST on Election Day
6. **TRACK** your ballot:
 - Check the status of your vote-by-mail ballot online at www.GoVote-Okaloosa.com or by calling one of our offices.
 - Enroll in USPS Informed Delivery at informeddelivery.usps.com

FELONY NOTICE: Under Florida Law, it is a felony to accept any gift, payment, or gratuity in exchange for your vote for a candidate. It is a felony to vote in an election using a false identity or false address, or under any other circumstances making your ballot false or fraudulent.
