- Move your polling place to your living room. Request your ballot by contacting the Supervisor of Elections office via telephone, email, mail, in person or by visiting our website. According to Florida Law, all Vote-By-Mail requests expire after each General Election. That means that at the end of 2022 all existing requests we had on file expired. To continue voting by mail in 2023 and 2024, voters will need to renew their request. Vote-By-Mail ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office by 7pm on Election Day in order to be counted. The last day to request a ballot is March 4, 2023.
- **Early voting** will be held Monday, March 6 Friday, March 10, at the Supervisor of Elections Offices in Crestview and Shalimar. Hours of operation are 8:30 am 4:30 pm.
- Your polling place (see reverse) for registered city residents will be open from 7am to 7pm on March 14, 2023, Election Day.
