- ♦ You may request an absentee ballot by phone, email, in writing or in person to be mailed to you. The absentee ballot must be returned to the Elections Office by 7 p.m. on election day.
- ♦ Early voting will be held in both Crestview and Fort Walton Beach elections offices from February 26 – March 10, Monday through Saturday. Hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- ♦ **Polling Places for registered city residents are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on March 13.**

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
